

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-74

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY- DIVISION OF DRINKING AND GROUND WATERS, FOR POTENTIAL FUNDING RELATED TO CYANOTOXIN TESTING EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF NINE THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$9,000.00)

WHEREAS, the OEPA- Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, in response to events related to cyanotoxins affecting public water systems, acknowledging that Ohio public water systems need a quick and cost effective means to test source and finished water for the presence of this toxin; and

WHEREAS, the OEPA- Division of Drinking and Ground Waters provides financial assistance to Ohio public water systems that utilize a surface water source; and

WHEREAS, the City of Huron desires to apply for such funding and considers this a priority need for the community and is a qualified applicant under the OEPA program,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the OEPA for funds as described above.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
