

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND (FUND NO. 226) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

WHEREAS, pursuant to House Bill 481 scheduled to be signed into law by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine, the City of Huron is eligible to receive certain distributions from Erie County of its distributive share of the County's coronavirus relief distribution fund.

WHEREAS, as a condition to receive this payment, the City adopted Resolution No. 2020-42 on this date affirming that the funds so received must be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Securities Act ("CARES Act") and any applicable regulations.

WHEREAS, all money received must be deposited into a new fund in the City of Huron's treasury to be named the "Local Coronavirus Relief Fund," which fund shall be identified as Fund No. 226.

WHEREAS, all funds deposited to the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund shall be used to cover only costs incurred by the City of Huron consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established a "Local Coronavirus Relief Fund" to be numbered Fund No. 226. Revenue deposited into this fund will be generated from distributions received from the County's coronavirus relief distribution fund, and expended to cover costs incurred by the City of Huron consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts thereof in effect at the time of passage of this ordinance that are in conflict with the foregoing provisions are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including R.C. 121.22.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare and for the further reasons that it is necessary to make immediate provision for the sound financial

operation of the City and to allow the City to make immediate use of the revenues derived from the Large Customer Infrastructure Charge; **wherefore**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
