Finance Department Operations

The City of Huron Finance Office will not be conducting any in-person business until further notice. In the meantime, the Department will be staffed. If you need to contact the Finance Department for any reason, you can do so utilizing the following contact information:

Water and Utility Bills: The next quarterly bill for water, garbage, and stormwater is due April 17th. ***In light of anticipated financial hardship, the City will be temporarily suspending any disconnections or imposition of late payment penalties.*** Our main goal is to continue to treat and deliver safe drinking water. Payment will only be accepted virtually or by mail.
