

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-47

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TAX LEVIES FOR THE CITY OF HURON FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023 AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND CERTIFYING SAID LEVIES TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council, in accordance with the provisions of the law, previously adopted a tax budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023, and;

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Erie County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with the estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of tax that can be levied by this Council and what part thereof is within and what part without the ten-mill charter limitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:


Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, levied on the tax duplicate of said City of Huron, County of Erie, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023, the following sums and rates (as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof):

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council be, and she hereby is, directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the County Auditor of Erie County, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. § 121.22

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the funds to be derived from the tax levies hereby provided are necessary for the fiscal operation of the City for the year 2022, **WHEREFORE**, in accordance with 3.06 of the Charter of the City of Huron, Ohio, the ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately following its adoption.
