REQUEST FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Huron, Ohio (“*Owner*”), at the office of the City Manager, Huron City Hall, 417 Main Street, Huron, Ohio 44839 on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February 2023 until 2:00pm current local time for the:

**“Huron Public Power New Substation Transformer Project”**

and will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter. The Huron Public Power New Substation Transformer Project includes procurement of one new 15/20/25 MVA on-load tap changing transformer for the Huron Public Power Substation at 1156 Rye Beach Road including services to deliver transformer to site, set it on concrete pad, assemble it, fill it with dielectric fluid, test it and commission it with concrete pad and electrical connections provided by others.

Each bid must contain the full names of the party or parties making the same, with an affidavit as to the interested parties, and in the case of a corporation not chartered in Ohio, with a proper certificate that such corporation is authorized to do business in Ohio, and shall be accompanied by a Bid Guaranty Bond for the full amount (100) of the Bid, in favor of the “*Owner*” or a certified check, cashier’s check, or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code, in the amount of the Bid, payable to the “*Owner*”.

It is agreed that the bid guaranty shall be for the benefit of the “*Owner*” pursuant to Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code if the undersigned fails to execute the Contract in conformity with the Form of Contract incorporated in the contract documents and furnish Bond and insurance certificates within ten (10) days after the notification of the award of the Contract to the undersigned.
