Huron Parks

Lake Front Park

N. Center St.

Scenic views of Lake Erie, the Huron Pier, Cedar Point and the Islands. Features: public beach, playground, gazebo, picnic tables, grills, drinking fountain, and restrooms.

Nickel Plate Beach

Tiffin Ave., to Nickel Plate Drive

Beautiful view of the Huron Pier-Lighthouse and eastern shoreline. Park includes public beach, picnic shelter, grills, playground, beach volleyball courts, permanent outdoor ping-pong table and cornhole boards (bring your own game supplies). Nickel Plate Park-Beach is dog free from Memorial Day through Labor Day during the hours of 10am to 6pm. Daily parking fee - \$5.00 per car. Season's Parking Pass: \$20 Residents/\$30 Non-Residents

Huron River Boat Access

Cleveland Rd. (Route 6), at the old ConAgra plant

State of the art boat launching facility. Free and open to the public, boat launching, day parking and restrooms.

Lake Shore Electric Trail

West end of Jim Campbell Blvd., adjacent to Huron High School Stadium

This 1.2-mile trail is named for the Lake Shore Electric Railway which operated an interurban railway on the site until 1939. Today's eight-foot wide concrete trail serves walkers, runners and bikers.

Oklahoma Park

Corner of Wilbor Ave. & Wilder Ave.

A quaint neighborhood park, offering a playground, picnic shelter with tables and grill, drinking fountain, and basketball court. No restrooms.

Andrew L. Fabens Memorial Park

Adams and Taylor Avenues

Huron's athletic park is home to 9 baseball/softball fields, 5 tennis courts, 2 batting cages, a nature trail, playground area, 3 shelters, picnic tables, grills, drinking fountain, concession stand, restrooms and a one-mile, paved pedestrian/biking trail.

Mile Long Fishing Pier & Huron Lighthouse

End of N. Main Street

Take a relaxing stroll out the Huron Pier to the observation deck...take in the surroundings of the natural landscape and wildlife habitats. Stop at Rotary Centennial Park at the base of the Pier to view a Lake Erie Sunset or venture over to the historical site of Flemmond's Landing at the intersection of Wall Street & N. Main to watch boats navigate the Huron River.
