

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1519.02 (C) -PUBLIC EXHIBITION PERMIT REQUIRED; FEE; BOND; RECORDS WITHIN THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HURON

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 1519.02 (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Huron, Ohio **WHICH CURRENTLY READS AS FOLLOWS**, shall be and hereby is amended.

1519.02 PUBLIC EXHIBITION PERMIT REQUIRED; FEE; BOND; RECORDS.

(c) The Fire Chief or Fire Prevention Officer and the Police Chief or other similar chief law enforcement officer, or a designee of such Police Chief or similar chief law enforcement officer, shall not issue a permit until the applicant pays a permit fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) plus any necessary costs of investigation of the applicant and of inspecting the premises on which the exhibition will be conducted.

SECTION 2. That, Section 1519.02 (c), of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Huron, Ohio is hereby amended to read as follows:

1519.02 PUBLIC EXHIBITION PERMIT REQUIRED; FEE; BOND; RECORDS.

(c) The Fire Chief or Fire Prevention Officer and the Police Chief or other similar chief law enforcement officer, or a designee of such Police Chief or similar chief law enforcement officer, shall not issue a permit until the applicant pays a permit fee of One Hundred Twenty Five dollars (\$125.00) plus any necessary costs of investigation of the applicant and of inspecting the premises on which the exhibition will be conducted.

SECTION 3. Codified Ordinance Section 1519.02 (c), as existing prior to the adoption of this Ordinance shall be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including O. R. C. 121.22.

SECTION 5. This ordinance will take effect thirty (30) days following adoption.
