

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-69

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PAYMENT OF MERIT COMPENSATION TO THE CITY MANAGER FOR SATISFACTORY 2019 PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2013, City Council passed Resolution No. 2013-67, which authorized the City to enter into an employment agreement with Andrew D. White to serve the City as City Manager; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.B of the employment agreement authorized pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-67 provides: "The City, at its sole discretion, may compensate the City Manager upon satisfactory performance evaluation, with a lump sum payment in a percentage amount as agreed by the majority of the City Council no later than 1 month after completion of the City Manager's annual evaluation;" and

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2019, members of City Council individually completed evaluations of the City Manager's performance during 2019;

WHEREAS, City Council desires to ratify and approve the payment of merit compensation to the City Manager for a satisfactory performance evaluation for 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager will receive his 2019 merit compensation payment on or before December 31, 2019.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:


SECTION 1. That this Council approves payment of merit compensation to City Manager Andrew D. White equal to five percent (5%) of his salary for a satisfactory performance evaluation for the year 2019, which lump sum amount of Five Thousand Six Hundred Eighteen and 08/100 Dollars (\$5,618.08) is to be paid on or before December 31, 2019.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately following its adoption.
