City of Huron - General Park Information

- Parks are public facilities; shelter rentals do not grant exclusive use of the entire park.
- Parks are open dawn to dusk unless specific hours are posted on premise; observe closing hours.
- All functions conducted in the park must be held in accordance with City ordinances, policies, rules and procedures.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in parks.
- Vehicles are restricted to designated parking areas and are not allowed on grass areas (note parking fee at Nickel Plate Park from Memorial Day Weekend though Labor Day—see cityofhuron.org for details.)
- Loud music, obscene language or boisterous behavior breaching the public peace is not permitted.
- Facilities must be cleaned after use. Trash must be placed in proper containers.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need to rent a shelter to have a picnic?

No— picnic areas/tables are available on a first-come, first-serve basis to the general public. However, this does not grant exclusive use of park facilities or shelters; anyone desiring *exclusive shelter use* must reserve a park shelter by using this form (other side). Also be aware that some parks host major annual events (for instance, Fabens Park Shelters are not available on tournament — call 419-433-8487 for date(s) or check cityofhuron.org—Parks & Rec—select "Parks").

2. What about larger events — like weddings or family reunion?

We recommend that you rent the shelter at the Park that you plan to use for a larger event; even if your event will extend beyond the shelter — this allows our department to be aware of your event; and provides exclusive shelter use for event set-up or food service. **Be aware that the park will remain open to the general public.**



Carry IN ... Carry-OUT conserves resources!

We encourage visitors to come prepared to remove their trash when visiting our parks, and to recycle as much of their waste as possible.

3. Can we have our wedding ceremony on the beach at Lake Front Park or Nickel Plate Beach?

Yes—**Be aware that the beach and park will remain open to the public.** Again, we recommend that you rent the shelter at the Park that you plan to use; even if the ceremony will be held on the beach — this provides exclusive shelter use for event set-up.

More points to consider...

- * There is a parking fee at Nickel Plate Beach from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day.
- * There are no permanent restrooms at Nickel Plate Beach; portable restrooms are on-site during the summer season.
- * There is NO lifeguard on duty at City of Huron public beaches.
- * Lake Front Park does have permanent restrooms; but parking is limited.
- * Other park patrons may be using the Shelter when you arrive. Politely notify them that you have rented the Shelter...others have no way of knowing about your event. Post the reservation sign provided with your receipt on the rented shelter during use. Have your rental receipt with you during your event.
- * Fabens Park Shelters are not available for rentals on tournament weekends. Visit **cityofhuron.org** (Parks & Rec icon—Select "Parks") for tournament dates, or call 419-433-8487.
- * Event tents are not allowed.
- * Sorry, we are not staffed to provide additional services beyond normal park maintenance.
- * Public beaches can be very busy during summer weekends.
- Refund policy shown on Shelter Rental Reservation form (over) applies.
