
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OHM ADVISORS FOR THE PROVISION OF DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES RELATED TO STORM SEWER REPLACEMENT AND CURB REPAIRS TO THE BRIDGE RELATIVE TO THE US 6 CORRIDOR PROJECT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED THIRTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$13,600.00)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to accept the proposal and enter into an agreement with OHM Advisors for the provision of design and construction services related to storm sewer replacement and curb repairs on the US6 bridge relative to the US 6 Corridor Project , at a cost not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Six Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$13,600.00) which agreement shall be substantially in the form of Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption.

Project Scope

The referenced project will resurface US-6(Cleveland Road) pavement from Williams Street to the Eastern city limits. The services provided with this proposal include: the design of a replacement storm sewer on the south side of US-6 from the western drive of Commerce Plaza to Berlin Road; details, notes, and estimated quantities for repair of north curb face of US-6 bridge over N-S Spur line; preparation of bidding and contract documents; and review and award services.

Task #60 Construction Documents

 - Typical Section for Pavement Restoration above storm sewer
