Items You Can Recycle

Help keep items out of the landfill when you waste less and recycle more. Here are the types of materials you can recycle:

Aluminum Cans

The aluminum cans you put in your All-in-One Recycling bin can be recycled indefinitely. Your recycled cans will be processed and reused to make new cans and foil that you'll see on store shelves.

<u>Metals</u>

When you recycle tin, steel cans and other metal products, nearly all of the material can be reused for future products such as new cookware, construction materials, electronics or even a new bicycle. Collect your recyclable metals in your convenient All-in-One Recycling bin.

<u>Paper</u>

You'll contribute to a long list of new products when you recycle old newspaper and other paper products. For example, that recycled paper can become new books, egg cartons, building insulation, boxes, kitty litter, sheetrock and even kitchen countertops.

Cardboard

Your old cardboard boxes and packaging are easily made into new materials with All-in-One Recycling. Cardboard is processed in our facilities, then turned back into new boxes and other cardstock products, while using 70% less energy to produce new products by using raw materials alone.

<u>Glass</u>

New glass objects are actually easier to make from recycled bottles than from the raw materials. When you recycle glass, it's reused to make new bottles and fiberglass that we use every day.

Plastics

Plastic is one of the most versatile materials when it comes to recycling. After our facilities sort by type of plastic, the recycled materials can be used for carpeting, backpacks, fleece jackets, play sets, plastic decking, containers and more. Much of what you use every day is made from recycled plastics.
