

Can I put more bags out next to the container? No, automated collection requires that all waste be placed inside the container.

What items may not be placed inside the waste container?

Construction debris, oil, paints, pesticides, automobile parts, batteries, tires, medical waste, deceased animals and other hazardous items are prohibited.

Will my collection day change? No, it will not change.

If I move, should I take my container with me? No, the container must remain at the address where it was delivered.

Are there any changes to bulk trash pickup?

Yes, beginning July 3, 2017, residential bulk trash will be collected on the first Monday of each month. Items that by size or weight are too large to fit in the container may be placed next to the blue trash container on the bulk collection day. Miscellaneous household furniture and appliances may be set out on your bulk collection day.

The City of Huron and Republic Services announce changes to the residential solid waste collection services

Beginning July 3, all residential customers in the City of Huron will begin utilizing new containers provided by Republic Services for weekly waste and recyclable material collections. Like thousands of your neighbors in surrounding communities, you will be participating in a program that allows for greater recycling participation and helps make your neighborhood much cleaner on waste collection days. The new containers will be distributed throughout the city beginning the 3rd week of June.

Solid Waste

- Residents should begin using their new solid waste containers on the next scheduled collection day after receiving them.
- All waste must be placed in the 95-gallon blue container with the black lid.
- Containers must be placed curbside by 7:00 am on your scheduled collection day, but no earlier than 7:00 pm the night before.
- Containers must be placed with the arrows pointing toward the street to allow for the collection of your container contents.

Recycling:

A 65-gallon dark blue container with a light blue lid will be provided for all of your weekly recycling needs.

Recycling containers will be emptied on a weekly basis on your regular collection day.

All items listed below may be placed loosely in the container provided:

Acceptable materials:

- Newspapers, catalogs, magazines, junk mail, office paper, soft covered books, file folders, and crushed boxes and clean pizza boxes.
- Cardboard from non-food items such as shipping boxes (please flatten, fold, or cut to fit inside the recycling container).

- Plastic containers such as milk, juice, water, detergent, and shampoo containers.
- Glass food and beverage containers.
- Aluminum and steel food/beverage containers. Empty and rinse containers and remove caps. Please do not place recyclables in plastic bags.

Materials that are not acceptable:

- No plastic bags or plastic wrap (these can be dropped off at some retail locations).
- No paint, pesticides or household hazardous waste.
- No Styrofoam, heavily soiled pizza boxes, carbon paper, electronic waste or medications.
- No light bulbs, flower pots, car batteries, scrap metal.
- No yard waste.

Yard Waste:

Separate yard waste collection will take place throughout the year on your regular collection day.

- Grass clippings and other yard waste should be placed in brown paper yard waste bags or loose in 32-gallon containers clearly marked as "Yard Waste" and not to exceed 35lbs.
- Small branches must be cut and bundled not to exceed 3 feet in length or 35lbs and should be placed next to the blue trash container. Plastic bags will not be collected with yard waste.
- Only organic material can be placed inside (no garden gloves, tools, hoses, plastic flower pots etc.).
- Do not place any yard waste in recycle containers.

Please review these other frequently asked questions for additional details:

When will my container arrive, and when can I start using it? Containers will be delivered in late June 2017, and you can start using it when it arrives.

How do I use the containers? Each container should be placed curbside at least three feet away from any other item (mailbox, parked car, low-hanging tree limb, etc.) so it can be lifted by the truck's mechanical arm. The container handle should face your house.

Must all waste be placed inside the container? The 95-gallon container is designed to meet the needs of most residents. All bagged waste must be placed inside your container with the lid closed. Containers cannot be emptied if items are left on top of the lid.

Can I put waste and recyclables in one container? No, please use the blue recycling container with the light blue lid for your weekly recycling pickup. The new 95-gallon container is for waste only.
