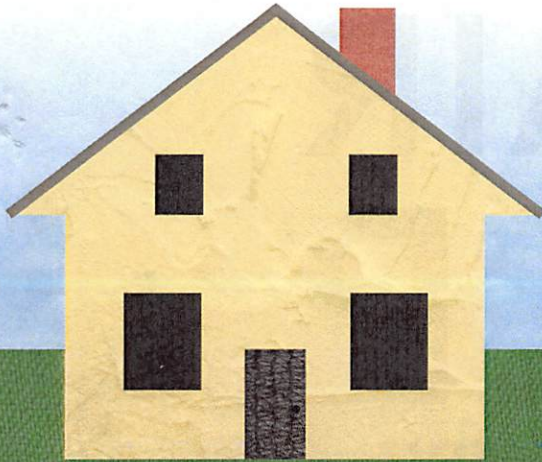
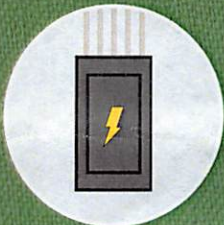


Erie County Home Repair

Electrical repairs from outlets to new wiring



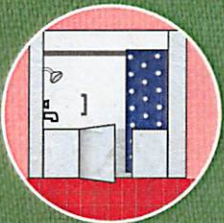
Exterior roof and other repairs to improve integrity



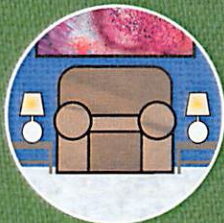
New water lines, fixtures, and other plumbing needs
