Subject Matter/Background

Resolution 56-2022 acknowledges the request from Angie Edwards of Huron 5K Series for the placement of signage on the walk bridge over US-6 promoting their 2022 race series, which includes the June 10th Liberating Hope 5K, the July 9th River Fest 5K, the August 13th Abbey Rose Trail Run 5K, the October 29th St. Peter Spooktacular 5K and the November 24th Judi Lively Memorial Turkey Dash. The banners would be no larger than 3' x 8' in size and would be placed 1 on the east side of the walk bridge and 1 on the west side of the walk bridge on the following dates:

May 25 through August 14, 2022; and
September 29 through November 25, 2022.

This is the fifth year for the event. Many different areas of the City will be showcased with 5 different race courses. The proposed dates of the events have been cleared by the Parks & Recreation Operations Manager with regard to any City event conflict and Chief Lippert remains involved with the organizers again this year with regard to safety services.

This request follows standard procedure and is being recommended by Administration for approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2021-41, ADOPTED DECEMBER 14, 2021, TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUNDING SOURCES, AND AN INCREASE IN ESTIMATED RESOURCES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2021-41, adopted December 14, 2021, Huron City Council adopted the annual budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022 for the operations of all City departments and offices; and

WHEREAS, Council has established various funds for the financial operation of the City, and through the current fiscal year certain funds have been determined to have insufficient funds and certain Funds have been determined to have excess funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the budget to reflect supplemental appropriations, appropriation transfers, and an increase in estimated resources to accommodate the operational needs of certain City departments and offices and to assure all funds of the City are in proper balance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 2021-41, adopted on the 14th day of December, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 2022-8 on January 25, 2022, as amended by Ordinance No. 2022-18 adopted on March 22, 2022, as amended by Ordinance 2022-24 adopted on April 26, 2022, and as amended by Ordinance 2022-25 adopted on May 10, 2022, is hereby amended to provide for supplemental appropriations, appropriation transfers, and an increase in estimated resources as to each fund set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance and the City Manager are hereby authorized to expend the funds herein appropriated for the purpose of paying the operating expenses of the City for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022 and to make the necessary entries on the accounting records of the City to reflect the appropriations and expenditures herein authorized to properly balance the various funds of the City.

SECTION 3. That, to properly balance the various funds of the City, the Finance Director shall be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to make the cash transfer between and among those certain funds of the City, in the amounts as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 5. That in accordance with Section 3.06 of the Charter of the City of Huron, appropriation ordinances shall take effect immediately;

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Appropriation Measure

Reason for Supplemental Appropriations

The following supplemental appropriation relates to Resolution 51-2022, 5/10/22. This approval is necessary to comply with the Ohio Revised Code and properly increase appropriations in Fund 401 for FY2022. The 401 Fund appropriations increase and increase to estimated resources stems from the cost to design and build the Cleveland Road East Sidewalk Extension. Additional resources expected from our project partner Huron Township and the ERPC-MPO grant.

In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, Council must approve supplemental appropriations, budget transfers above the City's legal level of control, and amendments to estimated resources. The expected net overall budgetary impact is +\$92,114.
