PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Huron will be conducting roadway restoration or pavement replacement on the following streets:

- Gateway Drive
- Beachside Drive
- Brunswick Drive
- Portland Drive
- Hawthorn Road
- Ironwood Road
- Magnolia Road
- Waterworks Drive
- Strowbridge Drive
- Huronia Beach Drive
- Salem Drive
- Gloucester Drive

Traffic & Access

- During Construction, the street will be closed to thru traffic and detour signs will be posted. Local traffic/access will be maintained to your property. Please navigate the construction zone slowly with your vehicle and be careful around construction equipment and workers.

CONSTRUCTION PROCESS

The project will proceed in the following manner:

- OUPS (Ohio Utility Protection Service) will mark/flag the location of existing buried utilities.
- Contractor's Surveyor will set stakes for proposed construction items.
- Road reconstruction will include the following major elements of work:
 - Reconstruction/Replacement of specified catch basins
 - The existing asphalt pavement will be milled off the street and base repairs will be made as required
 - Concrete roadways will be removed/ replaced or re-surfaced
 - Final asphalt paving or concrete will be installed as the final step in the process
- The contractor will also be replacing any areas beyond the curb which were damaged as part of the construction process. This will include spot repairs on sidewalks, drive aprons, and lawn areas.
- If work occurs on or near your driveway, the contractor and our inspector(s) will work with you to coordinate driveway closure times. You will be notified in advance of any temporary shutdowns, and be given an estimate of the total shutdown time. When the final concrete is placed, there will be a 3-4 day timeframe where your driveway will be closed. Alternate access will be coordinated with you.

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WHAT TO EXPECT

- All construction projects involve dust, mud, and equipment noise during the work hours. However, we will work with the contractor to keep the work area clean and safe at all times.
- The contractor will exercise caution around all buried utility lines, but temporary disruptions in utility services can occur. Report outages to the utility company.
- Operation of loud equipment will be limited to the construction hours of 6:30am to 7:30pm.
- The contractor will take precautions when working around private property which is located within the public right-of-way (30' from center of street). You may wish to consider relocating special or important landscape features yourself, onto your property, prior to construction, to avoid damage.
- Construction operations and contractor schedules often change during projects due to weather and unforeseen conditions. If these issues affect your home or access to your property, we will notify you.
- At the end of the project, the City will make sure that all areas disturbed by construction are returned to their pre-construction condition.

SAFETY

- The contractor is required to keep and maintain a safe work environment for workers and the general public. However, please use caution around all construction equipment and trench areas, and keep children a safe distance from the work zone.

PROPOSED SCHEDULE

- Start Date: Friday Jun 15, 2018
- Individual Street Schedules: Each Street will be completed within the overall project schedule. You will be notified of the schedule for your street when available.
- Final Completion Date: October 15, 2018 (final seeding and site cleanup)
