A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG) AWARD AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE AND 42/100 DOLLARS (\$146,971.42) TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF SPECIFIED EQUIPMENT FOR THE HURON FIRE DEPARTMENT


WHEREAS, in 2018 Huron City Council originally authorized the submission of an Assistance to Firefighters Grant application by the adoption of Resolution 2018-4 on January 23, 2018 and is now being awarded the grant in the amount of \$146,971.42; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the City Manager be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Department of Homeland Security through the FEMA Grants Outcomes system for grant funding toward the purchase of a certain equipment outlined in the attached Exhibit "A" for the Huron Fire Department in the amount of One Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-One and 42/100 Dollars (\$146,941.42), with a contribution of City funds in an amount equal or greater to 5% of the Federal funds awarded, or Seven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Eight and 58/100 Dollars (\$7,348.58).

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
