Proceedings of the Huron City Council
Special Meeting Wednesday, September 9, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

The Mayor called the special meeting of Huron City Council to order at 5:30pm on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 at Huron City Hall. The Mayor called for a moment of silence. After the moment of silence, the Mayor led in saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mike Spafford, Interim City Manager was acting as Clerk of Council due to the absence of Terri Welkener, Clerk of Council. The Mayor directed the Acting Clerk to call the roll for the special meeting of Council. The following members of Council answered present: **Sam Artino, Joe Dike, Trey Hardy, Joel Hagy, Christine Crawford, Mark Claus and Monty Tapp.**

The Mayor explained that Council is meeting to discuss the new business of discussing the recommendation of the Planning Commission related to amendment of the Zoning Code to allow residential use in the B-2 District. Adjournment


Motion by Mr. Tapp to adjourn the meeting.
