

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-77

**A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2016-54, ADOPTED JULY 26, 2016
RELATIVE TO PROPERTY OWNER ASSESSMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE
OKLAHOMA WATER LINE REPLACEMENT AND RESURFACING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2016, the Huron City Council authorized Resolution 2016-54, a Resolution declaring the necessity to improve the paving and waterlines within the Oklahoma Subdivision; and, to assess the affected property owners with the expense associated with the waterline replacement in the form of an annual special assessment for a period of twenty years; and,

WHEREAS, upon examination of the budget and identification of available reserve funds, the Huron Finance Committee has recommended that the Huron City Council consider the offset of the special assessment upon the property owners; and,

WHEREAS, the Huron City Council through discussion with and recommendation from the Huron Finance Committee has expressed a desire to offset the portion of the project which was previously directed to be collected in the form of a special assessment upon the property owners,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

SECTION 1. Upon accepting the recommendation of the Huron Finance Committee, the Huron City Council hereby desires to terminate the legislative assessment process related to the Oklahoma Water Line Replacement and Resurfacing Project as expressed in Resolution Number 2016-54 adopted July 26, 2016, and hereby seeks to repeal the same as it relates to the individual property owner assessment process. By repealing Resolution Number 2016-54, the Huron City Council expresses its intent to not pursue the special assessment collection process on the property owners affected by the Oklahoma Water Line Replacement Resurfacing Project.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption.
