

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-30

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FUND NO. 605-STORM WATER FUND AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON, OHIO:

WHEREAS, the city established a Stormwater Management Fee to generate revenue used to support a variety of services including catch basin cleaning and repair, street cleaning, storm sewer installation, inspection and repair, and provide funding related to leaf pick-up equipment or service commencing in 2018, and;


WHEREAS, the city must establish a fund to accommodate the revenue and expense to properly reconcile financial operations,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HURON, OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established a "Storm Water Fund" to be numbered Fund No. 605. Revenue deposited into this fund will be generated from the Storm Water Management Fee established by Ordinance 2017-16 and used for expenses related to all aspects associated with Storm Water Management efforts.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that, it is necessary to make immediate provision for the sound financial operation of the city.
