Proceedings of the Huron City Council
Special Meeting Monday, March 4, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Huron, Ohio was called to order by Mayor Brad Hartung on Monday March 4, 2019 at 4:00p.m. in the Council Room of City Hall, 417 Main Street, Huron, Ohio.

The Mayor called for a moment of silence. After the moment of silence, the Mayor led in saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, and then directed the Clerk to call the roll. There being more than a majority in favor of the motion, the Mayor declared the motion passed and Mr. Ginesi excused.


Executive Session
