Ms. Jennifer Litz responded to this agency to report damage to her vehicle. I met with Ms. Litz and examined her 2011 Dodge Journey (GQL5980). Ms. Litz showed me a small dent on the driver's side of the vehicle's hood. She stated the dent was caused by Mr. Alfred Parkinson when he punched her window, then the hood of her car.

Ms. Litz advised she was at Mr. Parkinson's residence to talk about their relationship. While there, things were not working out and they began to argue. She retreated to her vehicle as they argued. She rolled up the window and locked her doors prior to Mr. Parkinson punching the window. Ms. Litz stated she believes he would have struck her if her window was not up.

Ms. Litz requested Mr. Parkinson be charged for the damage to her vehicle. She completed a written statement which will be attached to this report. There was no picture of the damage due to it being barely visible. I was only able to tell the dent was there when I ran my finger over affected area of the hood.

I prepared one charge of criminal damaging (M-2) against Mr. Parkinson. He was served on his charge and allowed to sign a recognizance bond pending his initial appearance in Huron Municipal Court on July 5, 2019. Mr. Parkinson was further warned not to call, text, or go to her residence per her request.
