On 20 DEC 2019 08:43 Hours, dispatch received a report of a suspicious male walking near the north end of Oakwood Avenue. The caller was concerned the male might be homeless or squatting in vacant homes in the area. The caller also stated the male have gone into 16 or 18 Oakwood Avenue. OFC England and I responded to the area.

I made contact with the complainant and they advised the male was walking west along the lakeshore from the park area. The complainant said they lost sight of the male as he passed along the North side of 16 Oakwood Avenue and never saw him emerge on the west side of the address. The male was described as white, wearing a large brown jacket and carrying a blanket.

OFC England and I checked the area and did not locate the male. I did find footprints that cut between 16 and 18 Oakwood Avenue
