## **RESOLUTION NO. 8-2024**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, STATE FIRE MARSHAL FOR EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FOR THE HURON FIRE DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND XX/100 DOLLARS (\$15,000.00); AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT SAID GRANT AWARD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND XX/100 DOLLARS (\$15,000.00), SHOULD THE APPLICATION BE SUCCESSFUL.

WHEREAS, the City of Huron Fire Department desires to utilize funding opportunities available through the Ohio Department of Commerce, State Fire Marshal (SFM) to obtain potential funding to be used for equipment replacement.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURON AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** That the Council of the City of Huron hereby authorizes submission of a grant application to the Ohio Department of Commerce, State Fire Marshal to become eligible for potential funding assistance relating to replacement of equipment for the Huron Fire Department in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand and xx/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00).

**SECTION 2.** If grant funds are awarded, the City Manager is further authorized and directed to execute an agreement for and on behalf of the City of Huron, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Commerce, State Fire Marshal for a grant in the amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand and xx/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00), and which agreement shall be in substantially in the form on file with the Clerk of Council.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22 of the Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution shall go into effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
